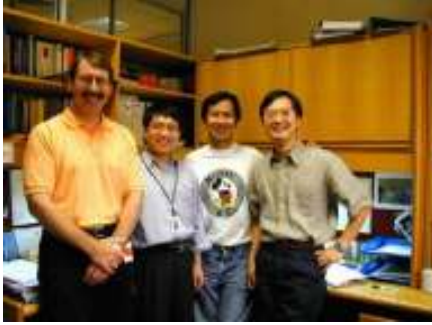
There is a better way!

- He has also helped designed programmes to minimise the risk of infection at the CMI.
